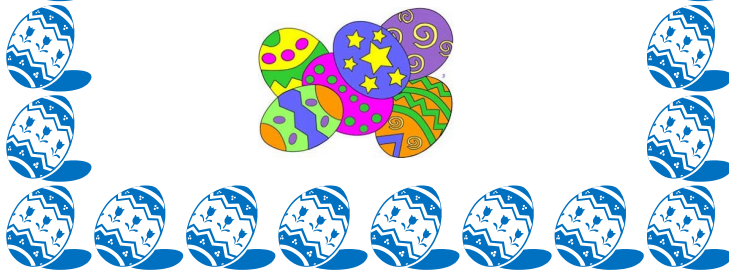
Easter Egg Competition
