This week, we have been visited by Megan Smith from Public Health England. She talked to many parents this morning about the different ways that we can keep our children healthy and happy. A big thank you to all of our parents who came. Megan also talked to the children about 'Fizz Free February'. This is an initiative that is being launched across the country to encourage all of us, but particularly children to give up fizzy pop for the month of February. We were all amazed by how much sugar some of our favourite drinks contain. Safer Internet Day

It is Safer Internet Day on Tuesday 5th February 2019 and we will be focussing on this in school.

Safer Internet Day 2019 will be celebrated globally with the theme: Together for a better internet.



Internet safety:

- Place your children's computers where you can see them, where possible in communal rooms.
- Always know what they're doing and who they're talking to.
- Explain to them that not everyone online tells the truth and they should never meet strangers without a known adult present.
- Teach your children the Click Code: Zip it (keep personal information private), Block it (block disturbing messages), Flag it (report anything worrying to you).

IMPORTANT ATTENDANCE INFORMATION
