Milk - Autumn Term - September 2017



If you would like your child to have milk during morning break from September 2017 to December 2017, when we break up for the Christmas holidays, you will need to pay **£15.75 before the end of term.**

If you are claiming benefits (child tax credit or income support **NOT** working tax credit) you may be eligible for free milk but will need to apply by filling out a form to entitle you to this. Please see the office for a form. **All milk orders need to be paid for at the school office by Friday 30th June 2017;** so milk can be ordered for the first day back after the Summer holidays.

Milk is an essential part of a growing child's diet. It contains a wide range of essential nutrients; energy, protein and vitamins and is also a particular valuable source of calcium, vital for strong teeth and bones.

Internet safety:

- Place your children's computers where you can see them, where possible in communal rooms.
- Always know what they're doing and who they're talking to.
- Explain to them that not everyone online tells the truth and they should never meet strangers without a known adult present.
- Teach your children the Click Code: Zip it (keep personal information private), Block it (block disturbing messages), Flag it (report anything worrying to you).

Important Attendance Information

As part of a revised school policy from 1st September 2013 we will make a referral to the Attendance Prosecution Service for pupils who take any unauthorised holiday leave. **Such a referral may lead to a Fixed Penalty Notice (fine) £60 being issued, and your child losing his/her place at our school.**

Our school target for attendance is 97%. If appointments in school time cannot be avoided, please ensure an appointment card (or letter) is handed to the school office **prior to the appointment. If your child is absent through sickness please provide medical proof in the way of medication labels or prescription slip.** Wherever possible **attend school prior to appointment and return to school following the appointment.** You should not keep your child off school for the whole morning, afternoon or all day. If your child does not return to school on the advice of the GP, **always contact the school to inform them of the outcome.**

Home visits will be conducted by the Attendance Officer Dawn Thompson - if your child is not in school a referral will be made. Please try wherever possible to avoid medical appointments in school time.
