

MILK FOR KS2 CHILDREN

If you would like your child to have milk during morning break from January 2018 to March 2018, when we break up for the Easter holidays, a letter will be sent out today explaining. Please fill in the slip on the letter and return with the correct money or an indication you would like your child to have milk under external funding, to the school office **by Monday 4th December 2017**; so milk can be ordered for the first day back after Christmas.

If your child is entitled to 'free dinners' due to benefits (child tax credit or income support **NOT** working tax credit) you will also be eligible for free milk. If you are on benefits and are claiming 'free dinners' and wish your child to have free milk. In order to claim free dinners you would have had to complete a form. If you have not completed a form to claim free dinners and need to please see the school office.

Your child is entitled to a free dinner under the universal scheme but this **does not** qualify for them to have free milk. If your child is entitled to 'free dinners' due to benefits (child tax credit or income support **NOT** working tax credit) you will also be eligible for free milk but will need to apply – please see the school office for a form to claim. If you are on any benefits and already claiming 'free dinners' and wish your child to have free milk please indicate on the form. If you are not entitled to 'free dinners' please return the slip with the correct money to the school office by **Monday 4th December 2017**; so milk can be ordered for the first day back after the Christmas holidays.
