In Literacy this term we will be learning about stories linked to the Ancient Egyptians such as 'The Gold in the Grave'. Maths

History

Science

This term our topic in Science is plants. We will discuss the importance of plants in the world as well as understanding how plants grow. During the lessons we will participate in a number of practical experiments directed from the children's interests in this area.
