










**Week 7 – Transition Year group: Nursery**

<p>Do you know the names of these colours?</p>  <p>Can you find and name different colours in your home?</p> <p>What about these shapes?</p>  <p>Can you find any of these when you are outside?</p>	<p>Practise counting up to 10.</p>  <p>Can you count backwards from 10? 10, 9, 8...</p> <p>Do you recognise any numerals?</p>  <p>Play a game and look for different numbers when you are out walking.</p> 	<p>Can you find your coat, put it on and fasten it?</p>  <p>Practise putting your shoes on and fastening them. (no laces for school, please)</p> 	<p>Do you tell someone when you need the toilet?</p>  <p>Practise going to the toilet by yourself, including wiping your own bottom.</p>	<p>Practise eating using a knife and fork, and drinking out of a cup.</p>   	<p>Do you tidy away your toys when you have finished playing with them?</p>  <p>Can you help someone at home with jobs such as washing up or hanging the washing out?</p>
