Try researching and reading online about an ocean creature of your choice. You could find some interesting facts about turtles.	Make an under the sea themed bookmark or reading area? You could include some of the new vocabulary they you have discovered over the week.	Listen to your child read and encourage them to read with expression. Can they create a book review or write a summary of what they have read?	<p>Alphabetical order: List each letter of the alphabet and think of a word related to the sea for each letter.</p> <p>Or</p> <p>Put these words in alphabetical order and then use a dictionary to find the meanings of each word: marine, barnacle, crustacean, coral and barracuda.</p>	<p>Try to imagine you are a deep-sea diver. Can you write a detailed description about the ocean and include specific species?</p> <p>Try to include adjectives to describe in detail what you saw.</p>	<p>Preventing Pollution Ask different family members what they know about plastic waste (e.g. plastic bags, six-pack rings) that ends up in the ocean. You could do this by creating a questionnaire and carrying out interviews. Discuss how you could help reduce ocean pollution and work together to create a persuasive poster to reduce plastic waste.</p>
