Get them to design a postcard and write about what they did there</p>
Maths – Multiplication and Division			Well-being		Weekly theme – Around the world
<p>Make a multiplication flower for a times table of your choice</p> 	<p>Your child can try to find real life arrays -this could be eggs in a tray, candles in a row, etc. Once found, get your child to write the calculation for that array. Can they find the fact family? (E.g. $3 \times 4 = 12$, $4 \times 3 = 12$, $12 \div 3 = 4$ & $12 \div 4 = 3$).</p>	<p>Choosing a times table of choice, ask your child to write a rap/song to help them remember the multiplication facts linked to this time table. Can they include the corresponding division facts in their rap/song too?
