



- Look at your new school's website. Look at the map of the school and find important places such as the toilets and the canteen!
- What subjects are taught at your new school? Are there any different ones to the ones you learned at Lodge? Which are you most looking forward to?
- Find a timetable of a school day on your new school's website and think about how long lessons are. You could even then use your map to plan routes between rooms.
- How is lunch organised in your new school? Will you be taking cash to school or using your finger print on a pre-paid account? Or will you be taking your own lunch? Make sure you know how this will work before you start in September.
- How will you make sure you have everything you need every day at your new school? Will you be taking a bag? Write a list of everything you think you may need and ask an adult to help you organise those items.
- How will you be getting to school in September? Spend some time planning your route. Do you need to catch a bus? Make sure you know the times of these. It is also a great idea to do the route, on the bus, a few times so that you know exactly where and when to go.
- Write yourself a letter after your first day at your new school in September, to be opening on your last day in Year 7. What are your hopes and dreams for yourself over this first year at secondary school?
