

English

In English this term we will be learning about stories linked to the ancient Egyptians such as 'The Gold in the Grave'. At the end of the unit, children will write their own story. We will also be learning how to perform poetry.

Maths

We will continue to develop our skills such as calculation, understanding number, multiplication and division to solve problems. During Big Maths, children will have the opportunity to improve their mental maths.

History

We will be assessing why the ancient Egyptians have impacted our life today and explore why preparation for the afterlife was an important ritual.

Science

This term our topic in science is 'Plants'. We will discuss the importance of plants in the world as well as understanding how plants grow. During our lessons, we will participate in a number of practical experiments directed from the children's interests in this area.
