

English

In English this term we will be learning about stories in the style of Myths and Legends. At the end of the unit, children will write their own myth through the methods of 'Talk for Write'. We will also look at persuasive writing and overcoming a monster stories.

Maths

We will continue to develop our skills such as calculation, understanding number and statistics to solve Olympic based problems. During Big Maths children will have the opportunity to improve their mental maths.

History

We will focus on the ancient Greeks and how they have impacted Britain today. Pupils will have the opportunity to explore the Greek lifestyle and their gods and goddesses.

Science

This term our topic in Science is Animals including Humans. During the lessons we will participate in a number of practical experiments directed from the children's interests in this area.

PSHE We will be exploring the Dot Com journal 'This is my adventure'. The topics we shall cover are, 'Feeling Safe and Uh-Oh signs'. We will be completing the 'Belonging' module from the Sandwell Wellbeing Curriculum.
