Archery taster sessions to be booked. - Give KS2 children access to a unit of archery during the academic year - To increase the percentage of children achieving 25m in swimming(Target Year 5 children who are close to achieving). TOP up swimming could be a possibility. Potentially improve provision by allowing another year group to receive swimming lessons - Ensure all children are leading healthy/active lives. Finances available to set up and run a healthy tuck shop - Improve the teaching of gymnastics across the school - Develop hall facilities to improve dance teaching through improvement in sound/visual and audio technology - Train staff for visit leader training - Improve playground equipment to allow for active play and help with delivery PE lessons.
