This terms topic is: 'People Who Help Us'

We are learning about people in the community who help us. We have had a virtual tour of a fire station and the fire engine. Please ask your child to recite the information text we have learnt about firefighters.

Reading books and **books for pleasure** should be brought to school every day. Please try to read with your child **every** day.

In **Literacy**, we are learning to ask questions and answer in full sentences. Say, read and write sounds in words and create our own sentences. Listen attentively to a range of texts and answers questions about what they have heard.

In **Maths**, we are using different coloured painted sticks to represent different numbers. The children have been working out how much each stick is worth by using their addition skills. The teachers have been highly impressed with their problem solving. Please ask your child to tell you all about it! We are also going to learn to recognise different coins and their value as well as 2D and 3D shapes.
