

English

In English this term, we will be focussing on a range of fiction and non-fiction texts based around our topic 'Great Explorers.' At the end of each unit, children will create their own versions of the story or non-fiction text.

Maths

We will continue to develop our place value knowledge and add and subtract numbers up to 50 as well as focussing on elements of space and measure. During Big Maths, children will have the opportunity to improve their arithmetic skills.

History/Art

We will focus on the history of great explorers Jeanne Barret and Neil Armstrong. In art children will have the opportunity to explore colour and creating texture through the medium of paint.

P.E

Children will study a gymnastics and dance unit focussing on skills such as rolling, balancing and jumping.

Music

Children will learn to sing and respond to classical music, instruments.

PSHE

We will be exploring the characters of Rory and Jasmine. The topics we shall cover are, 'Things I can do' and 'Taking Care of Me.' We will be completing the 'Belonging' module from the Sandwell Wellbeing Curriculum.

Geography

We will be looking at the different oceans around the world, locating them on a map before moving on to explore our local area using a planned route.
