

English

During this term, we will be learning how to write a warning story. We will base our story on William goes to sea. Children will rehearse the stories and adapt them using their own ideas. We will also write a set of instructions and a persuasive letter.

Maths

This term we are developing our understanding of number and calculation by using the four operations (add, subtract, multiply and divide). We are using our reasoning skills to justify and explain our methods. We are also learning how to tell the time and measure length, weight and capacity.

Science

Our topics this term is, Animals Including Humans. We will be identifying different animals and their habitats. Children will learn to recognise similarities and differences between humans and animals. We will also learn about the importance of keeping fit and being healthy.

Computing

To ensure that children are aware of the dangers of using the internet, we will be completing an e-safety unit. This teaches the children how to stay safe and protect themselves online. We will also be showing the children how to develop key ICT and computing skills.

Geography

As part of our topic, the children will be learning to identify the physical features of a seaside. We will use maps to locate seashores in the UK as well as seas and oceans around the world. Children will discover how landlocked countries do not have seashores and we will compare seaside holidays to ski holidays.

Music

During this term, the children will learn how to follow and identify a rhythm. Children will be thinking about pitch and tempo. They will also compose and perform their own sounds using a range of instruments.

History

Children will be comparing seaside holidays from the past with the present. We will be using images of Victorian seaside holidays and videos to find out what they were like. Children will consider how these holidays have changed over time.

Art

Pupils will be learning about the artist Claude Monet and his technique of impressionist paintings. We will be creating an image using the technique of printing. Children will have the opportunity to explore a range of media and choose which media they think is the most effective for their own

R.E

This term we will be learning about places that are special to the children. Pupils will consider the similarities and differences between the different holy places.

P.S.H.E

We will be exploring our emotional health and wellbeing using daily mindfulness techniques. Pupils will also be looking at how families care for each other and how we are all special.

Design and Technology

The children will research, design, create and evaluate their own puppets using fabric and joining skills like sewing or stapling.
